314 Minutes of the Monthly Meeting of the Council held on 11th December 2025

It was **RESOLVED** to approve, as being correct, the minutes of the monthly meeting of the Council held on 11th December 2025.

315 Matters Arising from the Minutes

It was noted that no further information had been received from the County Council in respect of the investigations into the developments at Glanbran, Cilcennin a Preswylfa, Ciliau Aeron.

316 2026-27 Budget, Precept and Council Tax

Detailed consideration was given to the draft budget presented by the Clerk. The delay in the purchase of the land for the extension of the Churchyard in Cilcennin was noted in particular and the need to provide for a sufficient sum of money to meet this cost in future.

Following discussion it was **RESOLVED:**

- i) to approve a budget in the sum of £15,870;
- ii) to approve a precept in the sum of £15,870; and
- iii) to set a Council Tax of £26.13 for Band D properties.
