339 Holy Trinity Church, Cilcennin Churchyard

The Clerk had circulated the latest correspondence together with a copy of the Land Registry plan for the Church and the churchyard. Unfortunately, it showed that a section of the churchyard had not been registered and that this was the subject of the Church to the parishioners for evidence as to its use as part of the cemetery.

The churchyard was inspected by the Members prior to the start of the meeting and photographs were taken for further discussion with the Church Authorities.

It was **RESOLVED** to take action to put pressure on the Church Authorities to expedite their investigation of evidence with regard to the ownership of the land.
