357 Minutes of the Monthly Meeting of the Council held on 21st May 2026

- There was a need to reclaim VAT
- Assets should be reviewed on a regular basis by the Council and any changes minuted, including their value.

359 Holy Trinity Church, Cilcennin Churchyard

Consideration was given to the answer received from the Church Authorities, stating that evidence from three parishioners had been obtained in order to prove that the section of the churchyard which had not been registered had been used over the years by local people, and that this evidence had been

provided to their solicitors. It was now expected that those solicitors would now evaluate this evidence and decide whether it was sufficiently strong to proceed with the registration of the land.

It was **RESOLVED** to provide this information to the Council's solicitor and to request him to press the solicitors of the Church for a response without delay

360 Any Other Matter

- a) The following developments were noted:
 - Cutting back growth on part of the B4339 was included in the County Council forward work programme and should be undertaken by the end of August
 - The work of re-placing the 'Give Way' sign near Tŷ Mawr would be undertaken soon
- b) The Clerk was requested to bring the following to the attention of the County Council:
 - a gap in the hedgerow on the minor road leading from Crossway to Llanerchaeron; and also a faulty street light on the A482 near Glynderwen, Ciliau Aeron
 - the adverse condition of part of the U5182 leading from the junction with the A482.
- c) The Clerk stated that Tyglyn Aeron was available on Friday 2nd October for holding a dinner and to proceed to reserve it.
